

The National Donor Deferral Registry (NDDR) is a confidential database that is utilized by plasma collection facilities and affiliated laboratory testing companies in the U.S. to assist in the collection of safe plasma. The NDDR is referenced for each individual who wishes to donate plasma. When your Social Security number, (INS number or other identifying information) matched information in the registry, the plasma collector could not accept your donation. The NDDR contains confidential donor information of permanently deferred plasma donors on the basis of viral marker testing, but does not contain specific test result information, so we are not able to provide any further information to you.
